State of Iowa, Madison County, SS. I, W. G. Dorrell, of the County and State, on oath say that I was personally acquainted with J. T. White, one of the grantors in a conveyance to Rhoda Hinckley of twenty acres described as follows; commencing at the north east corner of section two (2) of township seventy five (75) north, of range twenty eight (28) west of the 5th P. M., Iowa, running thence south one hundred (100) rods, thence west thirty two (32) rods, thence north one hundred (100) rods, thence east thirty two (32) rods to the place of beginning, dated on or about April 21, 1866, and that said J. T. White was then un married, his first wife having died, and he not yet having married his second wife; that the full name of said J. T. White was John T. White. That said Rhoda Hinckley or Rhoda Hinkley as her name sometimes appears in said conveyance, was the same person as Rhoda Hinckley who with her husband D. L. Hinckley on or about October 16, 1866, conveyed said real estate to John T. Van Orman; that the writing of the name of the grantee in the conveyance from said D. L. Hinckley and Rhoda Hinkley as Van Onnan was due to carelessness, the true name of the grantee being John T. Van Orman, who afterwards conveyed said real estate to Willis S. Clemons; that I have lived in said County during the time herein mention referred to, and knew personally all of the persons named herein, and that the statements made above are true as I believe. W.
