State of Iowa, Madison County, SS. I, T. F. Laughlin, of said County and State, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath, depose and say:- That I am the same person as the T. F. Laughlin named as Plaintiff in the action of T. F. Laughlin vs. Clifton M. Wheat and Dora E. Wheat, being cause No. 11504 Equity in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa; that I was personally present at a talk in Winterset, Iowa, shortly before the May Term, A. D. 1916, of said Court at which time the said Clifton M. Wheat, A. M. Jackley, his attorney in the matter, W. T. Guher, my attorney in said cause, and myself were talking about making an amicable settlement of said cause; that it was then and there agreed among all of us, including the said Clifton M. Wheat, that the said A. M. Jackley should enter his appearance in said cause for the said Clifton M. Wheat and said matter held open for settlement until after the said Clifton M. Wheat and the said A. M. Jackley should have had time to go to their home in Wayne County, Iowa, and see about making such settlement; that said settlement talk was pending and letters exchanged regarding the same until after the May Term of said Court for 1916 adjourned and we were unable to come to a settlement of said matter between ourselves and at the next term of said Court a judgment was rendered in said cause in my favor, appearing at Page 126 of Appearance Docket "I" of the records of said Court.
