Nicholson,of said State and County first being duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with T.D.Nicholson who on July 8th,1870 conveyed the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 19-77-27 to E.G.Nicholson,James M.Nicholson and T.B.Nicholson and I well and personally know that on said date the said T.D.Nicholson was an unmarried man and that he was the same and identical person as Thomas D.Nicholson to whom Michael Gabbert and wife conveyed said land on July 1st,1854, and I further depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with T.B.Nicholson and Sarah E.Nicholson who on June 16th,1872 conveyed the undivided one-third of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 19-77-27 to me and I well and personally know that on said date the said T.B.Nicholson and Sarah E.Nicholson were husband and wife,and I further depose and say that I well and personally know that J.M.Nicholson who was one of the grantors in a deed dated March 3rd,1882 and conveying the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 19-77-27 to James Harrah was the same and identical person as James Nicholson who was one of the grantees in a deed from Isaac Perkins and wife,dated September 28th, 1875 and conveying the 15 acres from the East side of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ^{NW $\frac{1}{4}$} 19-77-27 and the same and identical person as James M.Nicholson who was one of the grantees in a deed from T.D.Nicholson, dated July 8th,1870 and conveying the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 19-77-27
