I, Lydia Abrams, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I am the same and identical person as the Lydia James named in the registry of heirs in the estate of Benjamin James, deceased, shown in Probate Docket "A", page 26, and am also the Lydia Abrahams named in the registry of heirs in the estate of Hannah James, deceased, shown in Probate Docket "A", page 126, and as the Lydia Abrams who joined as one of the grantors in a certain deed recorded in Record "S", page 286. Also that the Sally James named in said registry of heirs in the estate of Benjamin James, deceased, was the same and identical person as the Sally Combs named in said registry of heirs in the estate of Hannah James, deceased, and as the Sally Combs who joined as one of the grantors in said deed recorded in Record "S", page 286.
