I, Hiram Davis, a resident of said county and state, being first duly sworn on my oath depose and say that I am the Hiram Davis, named as grantee in a deed of conveyance, dated February 1st, 1862, executed by A. J. Spearman, M. E. Spearman, C. F. Spearman and Julia A. Spearman, conveying the South East Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the South East Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twelve (12) in Township Seventy-four (74) North, of Range Twenty-eight (28) and the South West Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the South West Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Seven (7) in Township Seventy-four (74) North, of Range Twenty-seven (27) West of the 5th P. M., which deed was filed for record in the office of the Recorder of Madison county, Iowa, on September 30th, 1863, and recorded in Deed Record M, page 626; that I am also the Hiram Davis, who with Mary F. Davis, joining conveyed said land to George W. Wilson by deed dated October 12th, 1869, and filed for record in the office of the Recorder of Madison county, Iowa, on March 11th, 1870, and recorded in Deed Record 2, Page 319, and that Mary F. Davis aforesaid was on the date of the execution of said conveyance, to-wit: October 12th, 1869, my lawful wife; that I was well and personally acquainted with the said George W. Wilson joining conveyed said land to John Long by deed dated June 15th, 1870, and filed for record in the office of the Recorder of Madison county, Iowa, on May 2nd, 1871, and recorded in Deed Record 5, page 104, and was also well and personally acquainted with the said Elisabeth J. Wilson, and state that the said George W. Wilson and Elisabeth J. Wilson were husband
