STATE OF IOWA: MADISON COUNTY:SS. I, Sam C. Smith, being first duly sworn do say that the Arleigh Gray who is named as one of the legatees of Mary I. Bray in her last will and testament, which will and testament is recorded in Will Record D page 62 of Madison County, Iowa, is the same person as the Arlie Gray named as one of the heirs of the said Mary I. Gray in the registry of her heirs filed in Madison County, Iowa, and as the Arlie Gray who joined in a certain warranty deed with Stella Pullman and others, dated February 23, 1918, and recorded in Deed Record 59 page 221 of Madison County, Iowa, which deed conveyed to Byron Gentry the East 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres of the South Half of the North East Quarter of Section Seven in Township Seventy-five North, of Range Twenty-six West of the 5th P.M. Iowa.
