Hamilton, of said County and State, each upon our oath depose and say, that we have been residents of Madison County, Iowa, for more than 15 years last past; that we have been well acquainted with the title to and occupancy of the Southeast Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ), and the East Sixty (60) acres of the Southeast Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-four (24), in Township Seventy-five (75) North, of Range Twenty-seven (27) West of the 5th P. M., Iowa; that we each know that Joseph Henry Hoover (being the same party as J. H. Hoover) acquired title to the East Sixty (60) acres of the Southeast Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section, Township and Range prior to the year 1905; that we each remember when J. H. Hoover acquired title to the Southeast Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section, Township and Range in the fall of 1909 from S. S. Switzer and H. P. Anderson; that we remember when said Jennie I. Adams and Albert A. Adams were in possession and occupying said land about the year 1913, as the grantess or purchasers of said J. H. or Joseph Henry Hoover; that we each know that Jennie I. Adams and Albert A. Adams conveyed said land to G. F. Long, that said G. F. Long and wife conveyed said land to T. F.
