Gordon being first duly sworn, depose and say, that I am a resident of Madison County, Iowa, and that I have no interest in making this affidavit other than to establish of record the facts set out herein; that I was well and personally acquainted with the M. W. Jones who conveyed the South East Quarter (1/4) of the Northeast Quarter (1/4) of Section Twenty-four (24) in Township Seventy-five (75) North Range Twenty-seven (27) West of the 5th P. M. Iowa, to George W. Tague, by a deed of conveyance dated April 13th 1853, as is shown by Deed Record "A" page 104 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and that the said M. W. Jones was an unmarried man at the time he made such deed of conveyance; that the said M. W. Jones who made the conveyance above described is the same and identical person as the Mathew W. Jones who is named as grantee in a deed conveying said land to him, made by A. Buckingham and wife of date September 23d, 1851, and recorded in Madison County, Iowa, on the 15th day of June, 1853, as is shown by Deed Record "A" page 121 of Madison County, Iowa, and that his full name was Mathew W. Jones.
