State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, John S. Baker, of said County and State, being first duly sworn upon oath depose and say that I am the same and identical person as the John S. Baker to whom Lucy J. McDaniel, widow, conveyed the West Half (1/2) of the North west Quarter (1/4) of the Southwest Quarter (1/4) and the West Half (1/2) of the South west Quarter (1/4) of the Northwest Quarter (1/4) of Section Twenty-nine (29) in Town-ship Seventy-five (75) North, of Range Twenty-six (26) West of the 5th P.M., (and other land), by deed dated March 1st, 1919, and recorded on page 449 of Deed Record 60 of the records of Madison County, Iowa; that the personal taxes levied and assessed against John Baker in Winterset, Madison County, Iowa for the years 1891, 1892, 1893, 1894, 1908 and 1909, were each and all levied and assessed against some other person than this affiant, and the same are not now and never have been due or owing by this affiant and never have been a lien against the land conveyed by the above described deed.
