I further depose and say that I am well and personally acquainted with Henry Thomas, of Warren County, Iowa who acquired title to the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 20 Twp. 76 N. Rng. 26 Madison county, Iowa, and know of my own knowledge that the said Henry Thomas never lived in Madison county, Iowa, and owned no personal property in said county and that the taxes assessed against Henry Thomas in Ohio township for the year 1891 amounting to \$2 .50 are not taxes against the said Henry Thomas of Warren county, Iowa; and that none of the above mentioned personal taxes are a lien against the John Oller and Henry Thomas who acquired title to the above mentioned 40 acres in Madison county, Iowa.
