state, being first duly sworn, upon my oath depose and say that I was well and  
personally acquainted with the Wm. Wright who is named as grantee in a certain  
warranty deed from Anderson M. Bengel and wife, dated January 11th, 1900, conveying  
Lot 3, in Block 8, of Laughridge & Cassiday's Addition to Winterset, Iowa, and  
recorded at page 77 of Deed Record 14 of the records of Madison County, Iowa.  
That the said Wm. Wright died intestate, on or about April 15th, 1900, leaving  
surviving him as his widow, E. J. Wright, and as his sole and only heirs at law,  
Frank Wright, Edward Wright, Charles Wright, Myrtle Wright, and Walter Wright,  
and that he is the same and identical person as the Wm. T. Wright or  
William T. Wright referred to in a certain partition proceedings had in the  
District Court of Madison County, Iowa, on November 15th, 1900, being

claims and charges against the same were paid in full by his widow, the said
