State of Iowa, Madison County, ss: I, W.F.Craig of said County and State  
being first duly sworn upon oath depose and say that I am now and have been for 35  
years last past a resident of Madison County, Iowa, and well and personally acquainted  
with the persons named herein and the facts herein after stated.

That Al Tate, the assignee in the Assignment recorded in Mtg.Rec.64, page 312  
of the records of Madison County, Iowa, wherein a certain mortgage upon the S $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec.  
15: the N $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{2}$  and the SE $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{2}$  and the E $\frac{1}{2}$  SW $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{2}$  of Sec.22 and the East 2 acres of  
the SE $\frac{1}{2}$  SE $\frac{1}{2}$  of Sec.16, all in Twp.76, Range 27, made by John C'Johnson and wife was

released said mortgage on the margin of the record thereof on March 7, 1919.

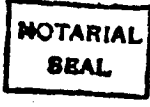
I further state that B.Johnson and Barney Johnson named in connection with
