Iowa, being first duly affirmed, depose and say that I was born near Earlham, Madison County, Iowa, where I resided for more than thirty years, and that I was personally acquainted with Lydia P. Smith who was a sister of my mother, and who entered the East Half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) and the South West (SW) Quarter of the North West (NW) Quarter, and the South West (SW) of the North East (NE) Quarter of Section Ten (10), 77-29, May 25th, 1854 under certificate no. 4647, patent recorded in U.S. record, volume 9, page 119, and that after the above said date, my aunt, Lydia P. Smith, was united in marriage with John R. Hibbs near Smyrna, Harrison County, Ohio, and that the above mentioned Lydia P. Smith who entered the above described land joined in a deed with her husband, John R. Hibbs, said deed being dated December 2d, 1867 and recorded in the Madison County deed record U, page 456.
