State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, J.E. Hamilton, on oath say that from the years 1898 to 1903, inclusive, I was well and personally acquainted with the Bank of East Peru; that during said years of 1899 and 1903, and during the intervening years, the said Bank of East Peru was a partnership, and that the members of the firm composing said partnership were William Fenimore and J.S. Emerson, and no other persons.

I further on oath say that I am a son of J.C.W. Hamilton and of Mary Hamilton; that Laura B. Quarten on or about January 6th, 1894 executed to J.E. Hamilton and S.M. Hamilton a quit claim deed conveying the South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Fourteen (14), Township Seventy-four (74) North, of Range Twenty-seven (27); that the said Laura B. Quarten was a grandchild of the said J.C.W. Hamilton and Mary Hamilton, and was the same person as Laura B. Quorten, as her name is erroneously spelled in an affidavit made by me on or about November 22nd, 1895, recorded in Miscellaneous Record 12, of Madison County, Iowa, at page 267 thereof.
