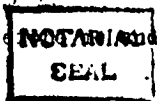

State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, W.C. Dorrell, of said County and State, on oath say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, continuously since in the year 1846; that I was well and personally acquainted with E.W. Herrell, to whom Alexander Atkinson and wife on or about April 23, 1856, conveyed the twenty acres off the south side of the north west quarter (1/4) of the South East quarter (1/4) of section four (4), in township seventy five (75) north, of range twenty seven (27), west of the 5th P.M., Iowa; that the writing of the name Edward Henard as the name of the grantee in said deed was a clerical error, the purchaser and grantee being said E.W. Herrell, whose first name was Edward, and that said Edward Henard as the name appears was in fact the same person as E.W. Herrell, who afterwards conveyed said land.
