Wilson, being first duly sworn, on my cath depose and say that I lived on the farm adjoining and including part of Section 7-74-29 from the year 1869 until 1915, and during all of said time I was familiar with the ownership of the MW. Fr? MW? of said Sec. 7, and make the following statement from my own personal knowledge, and that I have no personal interest in making this affidavit.

That the Elisha C.Stewart who acquired title to said NW: Sw: Sec.7 as shown by deed dated October 23" 1868 and recorded in Record "W", page 624 was the same and indentical person as the E.C.Stewart who filed a petition for divorce in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, on: August 17" 1871, and as the E.C.Stewart who conveyed said land, and other land, to I.W.Brownell by deed dated May 29" 1871 and recorded in Deed Record 7, page 173; also that the Wm.Barker named as grantee in a certain deed dated June 22" 1880 and recorded in Deed Record 15, page 582, was the same and identical person as the Will B.Barker who was granter in the above mentionedt deed recorded in Record "W", page 624.

That the Geo.Egy who acquired title to all that part of said NW1 NW1 Sec. I lying North of Grand River by two certain deed, one dated June 21"1880 and recorded in Deed Record 18, page 498, and other dated September 29" 1880 and recorded in Deed Record 18, page 567, was the same and identical person as the George M.H.Egy who joined in conveying the H2 NW1 NW1 of said Sec. 7 to Wm M.Kivett by deed dated April 22" 1884 and recorded in Deed Record 24, page 517, and that the Sarah D.Egy who joined in said deed was his wife on the date said deed was executed; also; that no part of said M2 NW1 NW1 Sec. 7 lies on the South side of Grand River.

That Charles Gilbert and I.H.Gilbert, against whom a certain judgment was rendered in the District Court of Madison Gounty, lows, on November 24" 1877, under which an execution was issued and by virtue of sale thereunder a Sheriff's deed for the NW NW of said Sec.7 was exeputed to J.D.Love as shown by Sheriff's Deed Record "A", page 144, never owned said NW NW Sec.7 and never made any claim of title thereto, and that the description of said NW NW Sec.7 in said deed was an error either of the person who drew said deed or of the Recorder in recording the same; that the land actually levied upon and sold under said execution was the NW NW of said Sec.7, and that the said J.D Love never made any claim of title to the NW NW of said Sec.7 under said sale and deed.

That wherever in the chain of title to the said NW: NW: Sec.7 the names Harriet B.Brownell or H.E.Brownell occurs, it refers to one and the same identical person, to-wit: Harriet B.Brownell; and that wherever in said chain of title the names Ira W.Brownell er I.W.Brownell occurs, it refers to one and the same identical person, to-wit:- Ira W.Brownell; and that the said Harriet B.Brownell were wife and husband on the date of each conveyance of any part of said land executed by them.

That the above mentioned Wm. M. Kivett and wife, Anna G.Kivett, each died prior to August 17" 1917, that their resepative estates were settled without administration and all claims paid in full.
