State of Iowa, Madison County SS: I, Michael Loftus, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath, depose and say:— That I am a son of Michael Loftus and Bridget Loftus, who formerly owned the part of the East Half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the South West Fractional Quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirteen (13) in Township Seventy-six (76) North, of Range Twenty-six (26) West of the 5th P.M. lying South of the Public Highway as now located and running East and West through said tract; that I know of my own personal knowledge that the said Bridget Loftus, my mother, died intestate in Madison County, Iowa in the month of August A.D. 1906 and left surviving her as her only heirs at law the same children and heirs at law that were left by said Michael Loftus, my father; that the said Bridget Loftus never remarried after <sup>the death</sup> of my father Michael Loftus; that the Amy Egan, named in the registry of heirs filed in the estate of Michael Loftus on October 21st, 1890 in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa was the same and identical person as the Ann Egan, named as one of the Defendants in the suit in partition brought by Michael Loftus vs. Catharine Burke and others in said District Court of Madison County, Iowa in which petition was filed on September 7th, 1906, that said Ann Egan was my sister and the spelling of her name as Amy Egan in said registry of heirs was a clerical error; that the Maggie Harahan, named in said registry of heirs was my sister and was the same identical person as the Margaret Harahan named as a Defendant in said partition action, and that the Agnes Loftus, named in said registry of heirs, was my sister and the same identical person as the Agnes Harahan named as one of the Defendants in said partition action.
