The State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, George Hornbeck, of said County and State being solemnly sworn do depose and say that on or about the 15th day of April A.D. 1851, I purchased from the commissioners of Madison County, Iowa, Lot number Four (4) in Block number Twenty-six (26) of the original Town of Winterset, Iowa, and that said conveyance was and is recorded in Deed Record "G" on Page 204 of the Records of Madison County, Iowa; that on or about the 8th day of January A.D. 1859, I sold the same to John H.B. Kerr and that said deed was and is recorded in Deed Record "E" on Page 573; that said deed and acknowledgment have my name, therein stated as "George Hornbeck, Sr"; that the George Hornbeck Sr. named in said deed and acknowledgment, and the George Hornbeck, signing said deed are one and the same person.
