State of Iowa, Madison County SS: I, Eda E. Vaughan being first duly sworn, depose  
and say as follows:

That I am a grand-daughter of James Goare to whom M C. Vaughan and wife conveyed  
the East 13 acres of the South East Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section Twenty-  
one in Township Seventy-six North, of Range Twenty-eight West of the 5th P.M., Iowa, and  
other land, by deed dated March 18<sup>th</sup>, 1882, as is shown by Deed Record 20 page 123 of  
Madison County, Iowa, and that I have no interest in making this affidavit other than to  
make a record of the facts stated herein at the request of the owner of the above  
described real estate.

That S.H. Goare, who is named as plaintiff in a certain action in partition filed in  
the District Court of said county on January, 2nd, 1890 as is shown by Docket M page 1 of  
said county, and Marcus Myers or Myres, Virginia McMillan, Mary M. Luckey, Isaac Myers or  
Myres, Ella Blair, Sarah J. Blair, Benjamin P. Myers or Myres, William D. Myers or Myres, James  
M. Myers or Myres, Miles Myers or Myres, Valandingham or Langdon Myers or Myres, Jessie A.

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Weeks, Alfred H. Weeks, Eda E. Weeks, this affiant, Eva F. Weeks, Joseph Lewis Weeks, James W. Weeks, and Magdaline Cline, who are named as defendants in said action, were, at the time said action was commenced and at the time decree was entered therein, the only heirs at law of the said James Goare above named.

That Sarah J. Goare named as defendant in said action is the same person as the Sarah J. Cline so named by mistake in the 6th paragraph of the petition in said action.

That Malinda Goare, surviving widow of the said James Goare, died intestate and unmarried in Winterset, Iowa, in the month of September, 1894, leaving no heirs at law other than the said heirs at law of James Goare above named herein who were the parties to said action in partition.

That I was well acquainted with the William Lindsay who is named as grantee in the referees' deed made by W. R. Shriver and others, dated March 3d, 1890 and recorded in Deed Record 36 page 32 of said county, and know that he is the same person as the William Lindsey who is named as one of the grantors in a certain deed executed to Malcom McDonald, dated May 1st, 1891 and recorded in Deed Record 30 page 460 of said county.
