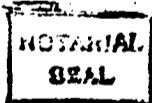

State of Iowa County of Madison SS: I, Harry W. Hill being first duly affirmed, depose and say that I am of sound mind and lawful age, and that I have been a continuous resident of Earlham, Iowa, for the past forty years. I would further say that I was personally acquainted with Israel Miller and Syntha A. Miller, his wife, who were grantors in a certain warranty deed dated June, 9th, 1911 and recorded in the Madison County record book 46 on page 451 and conveying the West 30 acres of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , all in Section 7-76-28 west of the 5th CP.M. Iowa. And that the said Israel Miller above mentioned departed this life May 21st, 1912 and Syntha A. Miller, his wife, departed this life May 20th, 1919 and that both were buried in the Worthington Cemetery about five miles southeast of Earlham, Iowa.
