Laughlin of said county and state, being first duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for more than 50 years last past; that I was well and personally acquainted with the William Shay named as grantee in a certain quit claim deed from John Cunningham and wife, dated June 21st, 1900, recorded in Deed Record 37, at page 470, of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and conveying the Southeast Quarter (1/4) of Section Sixteen (16) in Township Seventy-seven (77) North, of Range Twenty-six (26) West of the 5th P.M., and well and personally know that he was the same and identical person as the William Shea who died, intestate, on or about March 26th, 1911, seized in fee of said real estate, whose estate was probated in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, and as the William Shea referred to in a certain partition proceedings in said District Court, being Cause No. 10563 wherein Mary Shea, et al, were plaintiffs and James Shea, et al were defendants.
