State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, Walter Browne, being first duly sworn do upon oath depose and say that I am a son of Joseph M. Browne who was grantee in a certain deed dated December 4th, 1858 and recorded in Deed Record "E" page 566 conveying Lots Four (4) and Five (5) in the North East Section of St. Charles, Iowa that Joseph M. Browne died intestate on the 5th day of Oct, 1913 and was survived by Jennie A. Browne his widow, Agnes J. Browne J. K. Browne and myself who were his only heirs at law and I further depose and say that Agnes J. Browne was single and unmarried on the 5th day of April 1915 when she and the other heirs signed a deed conveying to H. D. Gborn her interest in the South 2 feet of the North 32 feet of Lot Five (5) in the North East Section of St. Charles, Iowa.
