duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I am well and personally acquainted with  
Chas. E. Tucker to whom Helen M. Milholland and husband conveyed Lots 5 and 8 in Block 1 in  
Adkison's Addition to the Town of Winterset, Iowa, by warranty deed dated August 21st, 1919,  
and recorded on page 493 of Deed Record 22 of records of Madison County, Iowa, and person-  
ally know that he is the same and identical person as Charles E. Tucker, unmarried, who  
conveyed the above described lots to Appauline Silliman by deed dated August 22nd, 1919,  
and recorded on page 518 of Deed Record 22 of the records of said County; that I am also
