State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, Allen Brooks Moorman, of said county and state, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I am a son of Thomas C. Moorman, who died testate on or about March 27th, 1903; and that said decedent was the same and identical person as T.C. Moorman, named as grantee in a certain deed from S.E. Funk and wife, dated October 4th, 1899 and recorded on page 20 of Deed Record 12 of the records of Madison county, Iowa.

I further depose and say that Susan J. Moorman and Rachel E. Moorman who are named in the registry of heirs filed in the estate of the said Thomas C. Moorman, deceased, are respectively the same and identical persons as Susan J. Turner and Rachel E. Landes, who are named in the last will and testament of said decedent; and that the said Rachel E. Landes and Rachel E. Moorman, is one and the same identical person as the Rachel E. Gray who joined as grantor in a certain deed dated February 24th, 1905, and recorded on page 112 of Deed Record 10 of the records of Madison county, Iowa; that E.H. Moorman, who died intestate on or about April 13th, 1900, was the same and identical person as the Eli H. Moorman, who is mentioned in the said last will and testament of Thomas C. Moorman, deceased, which will is recorded on page 97 of Will Record C of the records of Madison county, Iowa; and that T.C. Moorman, who is named in the registry of heirs filed in the estate of E.H. Moorman, deceased, as father of said decedent, is the same and identical person as the said Thomas C. Moorman, deceased.

I further depose and say that the estate of the said Thomas C. Moorman, deceased, was probated in the District Court of Iowa in and for Madison county, Iowa; that the last will and testament of said decedent was duly allowed and admitted to probate by said Court on September 29th, 1903; that Rhoda A. Moorman, who was appointed executrix of the last will and testament of said decedent qualified as such executrix and gave bond with approved securities as is shown by Bond Record E. Page, 30; that the said Rhoda A. Moorman, executrix never filed her final report in said estate and has never been discharged, but I know of my own personal knowledge that there were no claims against said estate and that the costs of administration of said estate were fully paid and that there now remains nothing further in said estate to be done by said executrix.
