Speer, of said state and county, being first duly sworn, upon my oath depose and say, that I was well and personally acquainted with Alfred B. Hood, late of Madison county, Iowa. That at one time he was the owner of the South East Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section One (1) in Township 76 Range 29 west of the 6th P.M. That when he conveyed same, through an error, the deed was drawn to read the South East Quarter instead of the said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section township and range. That the said Alfred B. Hood never had title to any part of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 1-76-29 save and except the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ thereof, and never was in possession of, or made any claim whatever to any other part of said quarter section, and the said deed to Martin K. Hood, of all of said quarter was simply an error and mistake
