State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, W.E. Thornburg, of said County and State, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath, depose and say; - That the William Thornburg who owned and deeded a part of the Southwest Quarter of Section Thirty-four (34) in Township Seventy-six (76) North, of Range Twenty-seven (27) West of the 5th P.M. to Henry Fudge, by deed dated April 30th, 1892, was my father; that his name was William M. Thornburg; that he never resided in or owned any personal property in Ohio Township, Madison County, Iowa; that the personal taxes against Wm. Thornburg for 1888 of \$1.06 and for 1891 of \$9.06 shown on the delinquent personal tax records in the office of the Treasurer of Madison County, Iowa, were levied and assessed against Wm. C. Thornburg in Ohio Township, Madison County, Iowa; that such taxes were never owed by my father, William M. Thornburg.
