State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, Clyde E. Fudge, of said County and State, being first duly sworn, do, upon my oath, depose and say:- That I am a cousin of James H. Mackrill, son of Charlotte Mackrill, who formerly owned an interest in the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter Of Section Thirty-four (34) in Township Seventy-six (76) North, of Range Twenty-seven (27) West of the 5th P.M. as an heir at law of Henry Fudge, Deceased; that I know that the personal taxes against Jas. Mackerill for 1900 of \$2.36 and for 1902 of \$2.72 shown on the delinquent personal tax books in the office of the County Treasurer of Madison County, Iowa were not levied or assessed against the said James Mackrill, heir at law of Henry Fudge, and were not owing by him but that the same were levied and assessed against another person by name of Jas. Mackerill; that said personal taxes were levied at a time when the said James H. Mackrill, heir of Henry Fudge, was ten and twelve years of age respectively and that the said James H. Mackrill never had any property of any kind of a personal character at that age subject to taxation. That I have no interest in said matter and no interest in said real estate, but the facts herein stated are from my personal knowledge and are made at the request of the present owner of said real estate for the purpose of removing an apparent cloud from the title thereof.
