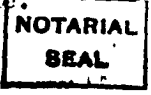

State of Iowa Madison County Iowa SS: I, John Cox, of said State and County, being first duly sworn upon my oath, depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Eli Cox, who died intestate in Madison County, Iowa, on or about March 22nd, 1865, and also with all of his heirs at law; that Martha Cox who appears in the registry of heirs filed in said estate, is the same and identical person as Martha Cox who is named as one of the defendants in a proceeding had in the Circuit Court of Iowa in and for Madison County at the October Term A.D. 1886 thereof, wherein petition was filed October 15th, 1886, and Calvin Ballard, Administrator of the estate of Eli Cox, deceased, was plaintiff; and is the same and identical person as Martha Cox who is named as one of the defendants in a proceeding had in the Circuit Court of Iowa, in and for Madison County at the October Term, A.D. 1885 thereof, wherein petition was filed September 30th, 1885, and Mary Cox was plaintiff, and is the same person as Martha Criss, one of the grantors in a Quit Claim Deed to T.M. Darnall, dated March---1900, recorded on page 339 of Deed Record 64 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and conveying the Southeast Quarter (1/4) of Section Thirty-six (36) in Township Seventy-seven (77) North, of Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the Fifth P.M.; that the Anna Cox, Annie Cox or Annie Duff as her name appears in the above estate, proceedings or deed is one and the same identical person; that the Sarah Britton or Sarah Brittain as her name appears in the above estate, proceedings or deed is one and same identical person; that the Mary Ellen Cox, Ella C. Cox or Mary Ellen Guiberson as her name appears in the registry of heirs, proceedings or deed above mentioned is one and the same identical person; that the Amanda Greenwood or Amanda Greenwood as her name appears in the registry of heirs, proceedings or deed above mentioned is one and the same identical person; that the Amanda Cox or Amanda A. Cox as her name appears in any of the above proceedings or deed is one and the same identical person; that the P.C. Brittain or Pleasant Brittain as his name appears in any of the above proceedings or deed is one and the same identical person. That in the allegations of the petition filed September 30th, 1885 in the Circuit Court of Madison County, Iowa, wherein Mary Cox was plaintiff, Dora Cox appears as one of the heirs at law of Eli Cox, deceased, but that she was the wife of Henry Cox and was shown as an heir by mistake.

That I am in no way interested, and simply make the foregoing statement to correct apparent discrepancies in the record title to the above described real estate.
