Connoran, being duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I have been familiar with the ownership and occupancy of the various parts of the West Half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 36-76-28 since prior to the year 1865, and know that neither Samuel B. Johnson nor any one claiming by, through or under him have been in possession of any part of said land or made any claim of title thereto and that Charles A. Gaskill and his grantees have been in the actual, open and adverse possession of said land during all of the time since said year 1863, and that the description of said land in a certain deed executed by Enos Berger and wife to said Samuel B. Johnson recorded in record "M", page 602 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, must have been the result of an error or mistake.
