State of Iowa, Madison County SS: I, C.A. McCleary of said County and State being first duly sworn upon oath depose and say that I am now and have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, for 53 years last past.

That I was well and personally acquainted with William McCleary who died seized of Government Lot 2 (or the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Fractional Section 19, Government Lot 6 (or the E $\frac{1}{2}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section 19, the North Half of Government Lot 5 (or the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section 19, and the N $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 20, all in Twp 77, Range 26, Madison County, Iowa, and other land, and that I was well and personally acquainted with his children and heirs at law, the said William McCleary being my uncle.

That the Alexander B. McCleary, Charles A. McCleary and George A. McCleary named in the Registry of Heirs filed in the Estate of said William McCleary, deceased, were the same and identical persons, respectively, as the Alexander B. McCleary, C.A. McCleary and George A. McCleary, who, among others, are named as grantees in the deed recorded in Deed Record 34, page 427 of the records of Madison County, Iowa; and the same and identical persons, respectively, as the A.B. McCleary, G.A. McCleary (two of the grantors) and C.A. McCleary (the grantee) in the deed recorded in Deed Record 34, page 434 of said records.

That the surname of said William McCleary and his children is sometimes spelled "McCleary" but that wherever the same appears as "McCleary" or ".McCleary" in connection with the title to said above described land it refers to the same party.

That the above named C.A. McCleary and Charles A. McCleary is the same and identical person as the Charles A. McCleary the grantor in the deed recorded in Deed Record 53, page 13 of said records.

That William A. McCleary one of the grantees in said deed recorded in Deed Record 34, page 427 was the same and identical person as the Wm. A. McCleary named in said Registry of Heirs and the Wm. A. McCleary one of the grantors in said deed recorded in Deed recorded in Deed Record 34, page 434.

That Sarah Olive Dillon named in said Registry of Heirs and as one of the grantors in the deed recorded in Deed Record 34, page 427 of said records was the same and identical person as Sarah O. Dillon, one of the grantors in the deed recorded in Deed Record 34, page 434 of said records.

That Margaret J. Grimes named in said Registry of Heirs and as one of the grantees in the deed recorded in Deed Record 34, page 427 of said records was the same and identical person as Margaret Grimes, one of the grantors in said deed recorded in Deed Record 34, page 434 of said records

I further state that I am in no way interested in the title to the land affected hereby, but make this affidavit at the request of the present owner thereof for the purpose of establishing of record the facts as herein stated.
