State of Iowa Madison SS: I, Owen Delaplain, of said State of Iowa and Madison County, first being duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted Aaron H. Delaplain, to whom the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 27 Twp. 75 Rng 27 Madison County, Iowa, was patented and who was my brother, and that to my personal knowledge he died intestate on or about November 24th 1854 seized of the title to said land, leaving as his only heirs at law, Naomi R. Delaplain his daughter and his widow Elizabeth Delaplain, afterward inter-married with one Jacob Alter. That the estate of the said Aaron H. Delaplain was long since fully settled and all debts and claims paid. That I am not interested.
