State of Iowa County of Madison SS: I, Harry W. Hill, being first duly sworn on oath, depose and says that he has been a resident of the aforesaid county for many years and that he was personally acquainted with one Evan George in his life time and that the aforesaid Evan George, deceased, during his life time owned a parcel of real estate known and described as lot ten (10) block three (3) in original town of Earlham in Madison County, Iowa, and that the said Evan George left a certain ^{last} will and testament; transcript of which was filed for record in the office of the Clerk of District Court of Madison County, Iowa, October 2, 1918, and that the said Evan George in said will directed that his said real estate be equally divided share and share alike between F. Marian George, Guelielma K. Fry, Emeline G. Hadley, Jesse C. George, Signa Hadley, Chas. Wesley George and his grand-daughter Mary E. George.

Further this affiant says that the aforesaid heirs and devisees and legatees made a warranty deed of the date of December 4, 1917 which was filed for record on October 2, 1918 in record for deeds, volume 21, page 167, in which aforesaid grantors conveyed said lot ten (10) in said block three (3) of the original town of Earlham as aforesaid to one Emeline Hadley

Further this affiant says that one of the aforesaid grantors namely Mary E. Beezley, with whom he is personally acquainted is the one and same person as the aforesaid Mary E. George, grand-daughter of the aforesaid Evan George and not another and different person.
