and that my mother, Matilda Rose departed this life in December, 1887, leaving as her heirs
her husband, D.H. Rose and children as follows: Wm L. Rose, Martha Rose, (Unmarried)
Perry E. Rose, Mary E. Kandle, John A. Rose, Emma J. Orsborn, Florence E. Dubi, and James A. Rose.
There being no adopted children, Matilda Rose died possessed of the following described
real estate; - The East One-half of the South-east Quarter and the West One-half of
the South-east Quarter of the North-east Quarter of Section Five in Township Seventy-
seven North, of Range Twenty-seven, West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Madison County, Iowa
which was conveyed by the above named children to their father, D.H. Rose, by Quit Claim
Deeds filed for record in the Recorder's Office of Madison County on November, 9th, 1889.

Further that my mother, Matilda Rose, left no will and that no probate
proceedings were instituted in connection with her estate, and there were no debts against
her estate.
