I, Cevilla E. Taylor of said County and State being sworn depose and say that I am the daughter of M.E. Bennett, deceased, who is the grantee named in the deed recorded in Deed Record 5 at page 382 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, wherein W.R. Shriver and his wife conveyed to said M.E. Bennett Lots 7 and 8 in Block 4 in Guiberson's Addition to Winterset, Iowa. And who <sup>also</sup> is named as grantee in the deed from W.R. Shriver and wife to M.E. Bennett conveying Lot 1 in Block 5 in Guiberson's Addition to Winterset, Iowa, and recorded in Deed Record 8 at page 225 of the Records of Madison County, Iowa.

That said M.E. Bennett died intestate in Madison County, Iowa

in August 1911 leaving Amelia Bennett, his widow, surviving him and leaving the following named children and only heirs at law, to-wit: W.E. Bennett, Celinda Menafee, Cevilla E. Taylor and Charles R. Bennett. That said Charles R. Bennett died intestate in Madison County, Iowa, in the month of January 1918, leaving Ida Bennett, his widow, surviving him, and Ruth P. Bennett as his only child and heir at law. That the estate of M.E. Bennett was never administered upon but it was fully and satisfactorily settled out side of court and all debts and claims against him have been paid and he has no other heirs at law except the above named children. that said real estate at the time of the death of M.E.
