State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, Frank K. Cook, of said County and State, being first duly sworn upon my oath, depose and say that I am the same and identical person as the Frank K. Cook, who together with Lorena Cook are named as grantees in the warranty deed from R. O. Mills and wife, dated February 23rd, 1918, recorded on page 334 of Deed Record 60 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and conveying the Northwest Quarter (1/4) of the Southeast Quarter (1/4) of Section Twenty-nine (29) in Township Seventy-four (74) North, of Range Twenty-nine (29) West of the 5th P.M., that I personally know that the said Lorena Cook was never a resident of Madison County, Iowa, prior to March 1st, 1918, and became of adult age less than three years ago and never had any personal property subject to taxation in said County prior to the year 1918; that the Treasurer's Delinquent Personal Tax Record shows unpaid personal taxes assessed against L. Cook in Grand River Township for the years 1901 and 1906, but that said taxes were assessed against some other person than the above mentioned Lorena Cook, and are not now and never have been a lien against the land herein described.

That the above statements are made from a personal knowledge of the facts.
