State of Iowa County of Madison SS: I Josephine M. Montgomery, being first duly sworn on my oath depose and say, that I am a granddaughter of F. J. Calkins, who acquired title to Lot Sixteen (16) in Block Eight (8), in the Town of Ego (Truro), Iowa, except 30 feet off the South end thereof, by deed recorded in Town Lot Deed Record 9, page 255. That the said F. J. Calkins died in Adair County, Iowa prior to August 28<sup>th</sup> 1902, that his estate had long since been fully and finally settled and all claims paid in full.

I further depose and say that the said F. J. Calkins left no widow surviving him and left surviving him as his only children and heirs at law, James F. Calkins and Sarah S. Slinker, who was my mother. And that the said James F. Calkins subsequently conveyed his undivided interest in said lot to my mother, the above named Sarah S. Slinker, by deed recorded in Town Lot Deed Record 10, page 357.
