STATE OF IOWA Madison county SS: I, V.L. Callison of said county and state on oath do depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with the heirs of Bluford Boling, deceased; and know of my own knowledge that the heirs named in the registry of heirs filed in the estate of said Bluford Boling, deceased, are the same and identical persons as the persons named as grantee and who executed the following deeds conveying the lands hereinafter described, to wit: That the Elizabeth Wilson is the same and identical person as the Elisabeth Wilson, who with Wm. J. Wilson whom I know to have been her husband, who executed a deed to Wesley Wilson conveying the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 10-74-28 (and other lands), which deed was dated Nov. 1, 1875 and filed Nov. 5, 1875 and recorded in deed record 11, page 468; That Edward L. Poling, Sam'l H. Boling, Julia Ann Boling, and Lucy Ann Boling, were respectively the same and identical persons as Edward L. Poling, Samuel H. Boling, Julia Ann Callison and Lucy Ann Bullock, who with James W. Boling and Preston C. Boling, and their wives and husbands who joined in the execution of said deed, executed a deed to Charles Boling, conveying the undivided 12/27th interest in the above described land, which deed was dated Sept. 4, 1875, and recorded Apr. 15, 1876, in deed record 12, page 320, the said Julia Ann Callison having intermarried V.L. Callison this affiant, and the said Lucy Ann Bullock having intermarried J.D. Bullock. That the Arthusa Boling named in said registry of heirs and the Arthusa Boling referred to in the last above mentioned deed are the same and identical persons as the Arthusa Boling

named as grantee in deed dated Jan.10,1880, and recorded Jan.14,1880, in deed record 18, page 255, and the Arthusie Boling who executed the deed to Alexander H. Wilson conveying the land described therein, which deed is dated Sep.10,1887, and recorded Sep.30,1887 in deed record 26, Page 370, and the Arthusie Boling who executed the quit claim deed dated Jan.10,1880, to Charles Boling, which deed was recorded Aug.9,1881, in deed record 14 page 300, conveying the land described therein.

I further depose and say that I have no interest in making this affidavit further than to establish the facts above set forth. That the records above referred to are all of the records of Madison county, Iowa.
