Cunningham, of said County and State, being first duly sworn upon oath depose and say, that I am a son of John Cunningham, who was named as grantee in a certain warranty deed recorded in Deed Bk. 33, page 264 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, conveying a part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, and the Southwest Quarter of Section 29, Township, 76, Range 26; that it was not the intention of the grantors in said deed to convey any part of the South Half of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 29, lying and being South of the railroad right of way of the C.R.I & P. Railway Company; and that said John Cunningham, or his heirs never had or claimed any interest in any of the land in said Section 29 lying South of said right of way that said John Cunningham or any of his heirs never were in possession of said land, and that none of them now make any claim to any part of said Quarter Section, lying South of said railroad;
