State of Iowa Madison County SS: I. J. L. Pinckney, of said State and County being first duly sworn upon oath, depose and say that I am well and personally acquainted with J. W. Pinckney, to whom Alex Bonham and wife conveyed the South Half (1/2) of the Northeast Quarter (1/4) of Section Eleven (11) in Township Seventy-four (74) North, of Range Twenty-nine (29) West of the 5th P.M., by deed dated October 7th, 1868 and recorded on page 71 of Deed Record 1 of the records of Madison County, Iowa, and who died intestate in Madison County, Iowa, on or about April 25th, 1898; that J. W. Pinckney against whom the Treasurer's Delinquent Personal Tax Register shows assessed unpaid personal taxes for the years 1886, 1887, 1891, 1892, 1894, 1895, 1896, and 1897, was a son of the J. W. Pinckney first herein mentioned, his full and true name being John W. Pinckney; and for the reasons above stated, the personal taxes have never been alien or charge upon the real estate above described.
