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State of Iowa, Madison County, SS; I, John McLeod of said State and County first being duly sworn upon my oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Edward A. Temple and Jane E. Temple who conveyed the E½ SE¼ 13-75-29 to me (John McLeod) on February 4th, 1857, and to my personal knowledge the said Jane E. Temple was the true and lawful wife of the said Edward A. Temple at the time of said conveyance.

I further state that I conveyed said land to my father on December 26th, 1856, in which my name is recorded John McCloud, jr, and his name John McCloud, Sen; also that my father conveyed said land to Christian E. Miller on October 18th, 1857, in which his name is recorded John McLeod, and that the said John McLeod, the grantee in said deed from Edward A. Temple and Jane E. Temple, is the same and identical person as John McCloud Jr who conveyed said land to John McCloud, Sen, and that the said John McCloud, Sen, is the same and identical person as John McLeod, who conveyed said land to said Christian E. Miller.

I further state that Christian E. Miller and wife Catherine executed to John McCloud, Sen, a mortgage, which is recorded in Mortgage Record, R, page 385, upon said land, and to my personal knowledge the said John McCloud, Sen, is the same person as John McLeod, who declared said mortgage cancelled upon the margin thereof.
