State of Iowa, Madison County, SS: I, William Brinson, being first duly sworn, on my oath depose and say that I was well acquainted with Andrew J. Adkison who acquired title to the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 13-75-29 and other land by deed dated May 31st 1856 and recorded in Record "D", page 541; that the spelling of his sur-name as "Atkinson" as appears in the record of said deed was an error either of the person drawing said deed or of the recorder in recording the same; that he was the same person as A. J. Adkinson who executed a mortgage on said land recorded in Record B, page 265 and is the Andrew J. Adkison who joined in conveying said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 13-75-29 to William Harris by deed dated November 4th 1856 and recorded in Record "F", page 141, and that the Anner Adkison who joined with him in said deed was his then living wife; also, that he was the same person as the A. J. Adkison to whom the said William Harris and wife, Mary E. Harris, conveyed said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 13-75-29, and other land, by deed dated April 18th 1860 and recorded in Record "L", page 707, and as the Andrew J. Adkison who joined in conveying said land to Andrew Johnson by deed dated August 10th 1861 and recorded in Record "M", page 416.

That the Andrew Johnson who conveyed said land and other land to Marium Johnson by deed dated January 10th 1879 and recorded in Deed Record 16, page 501, was on the date of said deed the husband of the said Marium Johnson.

That the E. W. Herrell to whom said Marium Johnson and Husband Andrew Johnson, conveyed said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 13-75-29 and other land by deed dated August 14th 1880 and recorded in Deed Record 18, page 523 was the same and identical person as the E. W. Harrell who joined in conveying the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 13-75-29 and other land to Wm. Ackleson by deed dated September 1st 1883 and recorded in Deed Record 23, page 158.

That the Mosby Brock who acquired title to the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 13-75-29 by deed dated May 27th 1875 and recorded in Deed Record 11, page 191, was the same and identical person as the Mosby Brock who conveyed said land, and other land, to William Brock by deed dated January 6th 1886 and recorded in Deed record 24, page 490; and as the Mosby Brock to whom said William Brock and wife executed a certain mortgage dated January 6th 1886 and recorded in Mortgage Record 19, page 538, and as the Mosby Brock who signed a release of said mortgage on the margin thereof on March 4th 1891.

- That the C. S. Wilson to whom Wm. Ackleson and wife conveyed the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 13-75-29 and other land, by deed dated February 12th 1885 and recorded in Deed Record 24, page 129, was the same and identical person as the Clark S. Wilson who joined in conveying part of said land to Wm. Brock by deed dated February 1st 1890 and recorded in Deed Record 30, page 182. All the above named records being of Madison County, Iowa.
