STATE OF IOWA Madison County SS: I.W.G.Dorrell, being now of the age of 83 years, on oath say that I have been a resident of Madison County, Iowa, continuously for more than seventy-two (72) years last past; that I was acquainted with Andrew Hutson to whom was patented the South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), and the North Half (N $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-two (32), in Township Seventy-six (76) North, of Range Twenty-seven (27) West of the 5th P.M. Iowa., and that he was the same and identical person as the Andrew Hutson who, on or about April 5th, 1852, conveyed the North Half (N $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section, Township and Range to Thompson Spenceer.

That I was personally acquainted with Christie K. Lindsay to whom Samuel B. Barker, on or about July 8th, 1854, conveyed the eighty acre tract last above described, and that he was the same and identical person as the C.K. Lindsay who, on or about May 26th, 1855, conveyed the undivided One-half of said real estate to William E. Davidson and that he was the same and identical person as the C.K. Lindsay who, on or about September 17th, 1855, conveyed the other one-half of said real-estate to the said William E. Davidson, and that after said conveyances to William E. Davidson, the said C.K. Lindsay or Christie K. Lindsay had no further interest in said real estate; that said William E. Davidson had taken possession of all of the same.

That I was also personally acquainted with S.A. Mackey to whom W.W. Mc Knight and wife on or about December 14th, 1867, executed a conveyance of the eighty acres last above described, and that he was the same and identical person as the Samuel A. Mackey who, on or about December 23rd, 1867, conveyed said real estate to Amos Decon.

That I have been personally acquainted with all of the persons herein named, and that the facts above stated are true, as I believe.
