I, Anderson Barnett, of said County and State being first duly sworn on oath depose and say that I was well and personally acquainted with Joshua Bennett and Nancy Bennett who on the 1st. day of August A.D. 1864 deeded the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 3 Township 77, North Range 28, West 5th P. M. Iowa, to one David Beesley, and that they were husband and wife at that time.

That I was also well and personally acquainted with Eunice I Beesley, named as one of the grantees in a deed to the above land, which is recorded in Deed Record 15, page 335 thereof. And Eunice E Beesley wife of David Beesley one of the grantors in a deed recorded in Deed Record 28 page 582, all Madison County Iowa records, and that they are one and the same person.

That Josiah Bennett named as grantee in the Original Entry of said lands found recorded in U.S. Record 8 page 200, And Joshua Bennett named as grantor in a warranty deed found in Deed Record 8 page 650, conveying said land, are one and the same person.
