State of Iowa Dallas County SS: I, Henry Campbell being first duly sworn on oath depose and say, that I am the identical Henry Campbell, who formerly owned the North 116.8 acres of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 7, Township 76, North, Range 29 west of the fifth P.M. in Madison County, Iowa, as shown by deed recorded in book 58 page 571 of the records of Madison County, Iowa. That I am credibly informed that the records of Madison County, Iowa show unpaid personal tax for the year 1890 assessed in Jackson Township, Madison County, Iowa against one, C.H. Campbell in the amount of \$1.92, and also that said record show unpaid personal tax for the year 1896 assessed in Winterset, Madison County, Iowa against one, H.P. Campbell and I do state that if the records of Madison County, Iowa, so show such unpaid taxes that said tax in either instance is not a lien upon the above described real estate; that same was not assessed against this affiant, Henry

Campbell, that I have never been a resident of Madison County, Iowa; that I had no personal property whatsoever in Jackson township, Madison County, Iowa, in the year 1890, nor had I any personal property whatsoever in Winterset, Iowa in the year 1896, against which said taxes could have been levied and assessed; that I have never owned any property personal or real in Madison County, Iowa, at any time, except the real estate above described.
