State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, George Haymond, of said State and County, first being duly sworn, upon my oath depose and say that I have been personally acquainted with the tract of real estate known as the Slaughter House Lot and described in certain conveyances of record as follows, to-wit:

Two (2) acres in a triangular form in the Northeast corner of the Southeast Quarter (1/4) of Section Two (2) in Township Seventy-five (75) North of Range Twenty-eight (28) West, of the 5th P.M. for more than Twenty (20) years last past.

That at time this affiant became acquainted with said Slaughter House Lot there was then a fence such as would be expected around a Lot used for such purposes, running in a straight line from the North line of the Government sub-division to the East line of said Government sub-division and the boundary line was then well defined and had the appearance of having been so used for many years prior thereto.

That from the first time that this affiant became acquainted with said Slaughter House Lot, the location of the diagonal fence on the South and West of said Lot was not changed until subsequent to the time that this affiant conveyed said Lot to R.C. (or Ralph) Barcroft.

This affiant further states that from the time this affiant first knew this property until after he conveyed the same, that the diagonal fence on the West and South of said Lot was at all times the agreed line between the owners of the Slaughter House Lot and the owners of that part of said Government sub-division adjoining said Slaughter House Lot.
