State of Iowa Madison County SS: I, I. E. T. Wilson of said State and County, first being duly sworn, upon oath depose and say that I now am and for many years last past have been engaged in conducting a meat market in Winterset, Iowa, and during said time have slaughtered many of the hogs and cattle for my market.

That in connection with my business this affiant became acquainted in 1890 with a tract of real estate used as a Slaughter House, known and described in certain conveyances of record, as:-

Two (2) acres in a triangular form in the Northeast Corner of the Southeast Quarter (¼) of Section Two (2) in Township Seventy-five (75) North, of Range Twenty-eight (28) West of the 5th P.M.

That at ^{the} time this affiant became acquainted with said tract there was a slaughter house thereon and the whole of the tract was used as yards in connection with said house and at that time had the appearance of having been so used for many years prior thereto.

That there was then a fence such as would be expected around such Lot, running in a straight line from the North line of said Government subdivision to said East line of said Government sub-division and that the boundary line was well defined.

That from the year 1890 to 1905 the location of the diagonal fence on the South and West of said slaughter house lot was not changed, and during all of said period of time and for some time subsequent thereto unknown to this affiant the said fence was at all times the agreed line between the owners of the slaughter house Lot and the owners of that part of the Northeast Quarter (¼) of the Southeast Quarter (¼) adjoining the slaughter house Lot.
