State of Iowa Madison County SSI I,S.S.Morgan, first being duly sworn do upon my oath depose and say that I am a son of Oliver Morgan who died intestate in Madison County, Iowa, on or about the 3rd, day of November A.D.1877. That I am the same person who was named in the registry of heirs in the matter of the estate of the said Oliver Morgan, deceased, as Sylvester S.Morgan. That the said Oliver Morgan left surviving him a daughter named Sarah S.Kimer, she having married one, Wm.Kimer, prior to the death of her father Oliver Morgan. That the said Sarah S.Kimer is the same person who was named in said registry of heirs as "Sarah S.Kinner" and she is the same person who was named as ^a defendant in the partition proceedings which petition was filed in the Circuit Court of Iowa; in and for Madison County, on or about the 1st, day of March A.D.1881, wherein the said Sarah Kimer was named "Sarah Keinereen" and her husband was named Wm.Keinereen, and the said Sarah Kimer and Wm.Kimer are the same persons who were named in the Original Notice in said proceeding Sarah Keinereen and Wm.Keinereen, and the said Sarah Kimer is the same person who was named in the decree in said action as Sarah Kimern and in another place in said decree named Sarah Kinner and the said Wm.Kimer is the same person who was in the said decree named Wm.Kimner, and I am the same person who was named in the return of service of Original Notice in said cause Silvester Morgan: That the Bersheba S.Linscott named in the
