State of Iowa Madison County SS: I,W.S.Cooper, on oath say that I was attorney for plaintiff in the cases brought in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, Against J.G. Smith, in one of which New Home Sewing Machine Company was plaintiff, which appears on Judgment Docket "X" of said Court at page 247 thereof, judgment being entered on October 3rd, 1917, for \$137.18, with interest and costs; the other being in a case in which Hugh Nelson was plaintiff, which appears on judgment Docket "X" of said Court, at page 255 thereof, judgment entered on October 3rd, 1917, for \$108.00 and costs; that said J.G. Smith was a man who had been in the merchantile business at St. Charles, Iowa, and was not the John G. Smith or John H.B. Smith who was a son of A.B. Smith or Asa B. Smith who died in Madison County, Iowa, on or about October 12th, 1914; and who is named; that said John M.G. Smith or John G. Smith as his name appears in the registry of heirs of said A.B. Smith and in the

partition suit brought in the District Court of Madison County, Iowa, by Elisabeth Banks, was not the same person as the J.G. Smith against whom said judgments were rendered.

That I am personally acquainted with all the members of the family of said A.B. Smith or Ana B. Smith now deceased.

That Robert Albert Roy Smith and Walter Aron Wood Smith who on or about June 17th, 1918, executed to Elijah Sylvester Calvin Smith a deed conveying their interest in the north west quarter (1/4) of the south west quarter (1/4) of section thirty four (34), township seventy seven (77) north, of range twenty eight (28), west of the Fifth P.M., Iowa, recorded in deed record 57 of Madison County, Iowa, at page 178 are the same persons as Roy Smith and W.A. Smith respectively, named in the registry of heirs of said A.B. Smith; that William Terry Smith who on or about the 14th day of October, A.D. 1918, executed to Elijah Sylvester Smith a conveyance of the undivided two twenty sevenths of the same real estate, which is recorded in deed record 60 of said County at page 361 is the same person as W.T. Smith named in said registry of heirs that Stephen E. Smith who on or about December 21st, 1918; executed to Elisabeth Banks a conveyance of the undivided two twenty sevenths of said real estate, which deed is recorded in deed record 62 of said County, at page 51 is the same person as S.E. Smith named in said registry of heirs; that Elijah Smith named in said registry of heirs is the same person as Elijah Sylvester Calvin Smith, and as Elijah Sylvester Smith above referred to, and is also the same person as Elijah Sylvester Smith grantee in a conveyance from Mary M. Smith of the undivided one third of said real estate, dated October 12th, 1918, and recorded in deed record 60 of said County, page 362 thereof, and is also the same person as Elijah S.C. Smith defendants in a partition suit brought by Elisabeth Banks, at the December Term A.D. 1918, of the District Court of said County.

That I am not interested in the subject matter of this affidavit, but make the same for the purpose of establishing the facts of record.
