Smith, late of Madison County, Iowa, deceased; that I am a brother of W.T. Smith a son of said A.B. Smith or Asa B. Smith, and that the W.T. Smith against whom unpaid personal taxes appear in Scott township, Madison County, Iowa, is some other W.T. Smith than my brother; that my brother W.T. Smith never lived in Scott township in said County, or had any property therein, and was never assessed in said township; that I am a brother of John G. Smith, a son of said A.B. Smith or Asa B. Smith, and that the John Smith against whom unpaid personal taxes appear in Union, Crawford, and Penn townships, in Madison County, Iowa, is some person other than my said brother John G. Smith; that said John G. Smith never lived in or had property in any of said townships, and was never assessed in any of said townships, and that he has been a resident of the State of Oklahoma for more than 25 years last past. That the Walter Smith or A.W. Smith against whom unpaid personal taxes appear assessed in Winterset, was some person other than my brother W.A. Smith or Walter Aron Wood Smith, as he never lived in Winterset, or had any property therein, and was never assessed there; That Grant Smith against whom unpaid personal taxes appear in Winterset, Iowa, assessed in 1911, Smith & Kephart against whom unpaid personal taxes appear assessed in Grand River township assessed in 1902,

Smith, who died in Madison County, Iowa, on or about October 12th, 1914, owning at the time of his death the north west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the south west quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section thirty four (34), township seventy seven (77) north, of range twenty eight (28), west of the 5th P.M. Iowa.
