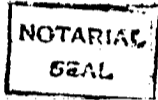

That my brother Joel Campbell has not been heard of since long prior to the death of my father; that 17 or 18 years ago the said Joel Campbell went to the Dominion of Canada and that he was a single and unmarried man at that time, and that he has not been heard of or heard from by any members of our family since that time; that I was the administrator of the estate of my father who died about 15 years ago, and that I made every possible effort to find my brother at that time, in order that I might give him his interest in our father's estate, but that I have never been able to get any trace of him whatever, and in the final settlement of my father's estate, I deposited his interest with the Clerk of the District Court in which said estate was settled; that he had kept in touch with the members of our family prior to the time he went to Canada, but from that time on none have ever heard from him.
